16/03/19 - FLOOD BARRIERS FOR RIVER SEVERN

Dear all,

Due to the heavy rainfall in Wales, Telford & Wrekin Council have received early notification from the Environment Agency that the Flood Barriers will be deployed in Ironbridge at on Sunday 17th March. It is expected that this will be made public to all residents in Ironbridge signed up to the Environment Agency's flood warning service, and the deployment will also be widely publicised on both the Environment Agency and Telford & Wrekin Council's social media pages. Prior to the deployment of the barriers Telford & Wrekin Council's Engineering Teams will be in the Gorge today to set out no parking cones along the parking bays on the Wharfage, installing stoppers in the highway gullies, and setting up the diversion signage in preparation for the event.

During the deployment Telford & Wrekin Council will cease charging on all Council car parks in Ironbridge allowing residents to park in these for free.

The Wharfage will be closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic from 6am on Sunday morning.

Although the highway will be closed Telford & Wrekin Council will ensure that all businesses can remain open and operational during the deployment, and will ensure that the public are aware that Ironbridge is open for business as usual with clear signage along the diversion routes. Telford & Wrekin Council staff will be on site throughout the deployment to assist businesses and members of the public wherever possible.
